Social Distancing Students are to arrive dressed and ready for class, a dance bag is required and to be taken into the studio with their kit (see kit list below). Large bulky outdoor coats /Jackets are to be left with parent /carer. Outdoor shoes and hoodies are to be placed securely in the dance bag and are to be taken into the studios dance shoes are to be put on before entering the studio no bare feet where possible. Students will enter the studios via the usual doors and exit via the small studio door at the back. Students will be allocated a dance area which they are to remain in to maintain the government social distancing requirements. Staff and children will be reminded of the importance of social distancing both in the studios and outside of it. Posters will be displayed where appropriate to remind students of current guidance. Ventilation Doors and windows will remain open whenever possible to maximise ventilation in the studios.	High

Hand Washing

Students should use their own hand sanitiser at the door before entering the studios. (Alcohol based sanitising gel will be available in the studio if needed).

Hand washing facilities with soap, water and paper towels will be available in the toilet if required. We advise you 'go' before coming to the studio and use your own hand towel after washing.

Students and families are reminded to wash hands thoroughly when returning home from the studios.

Staff and children will be reminded of the importance of regular hand washing both in the studios and outside of it. Posters will be displayed where appropriate to remind students of current guidance.

Respiratory Hygiene

Students will be reminded of the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' policy. Tissues must be placed in lidded bins which will be emptied at the end of each day.

Additional Cleaning

Door handles and barres will be wiped down with disinfectant / anti-bacterial wipes after each lesson.

Other frequently touched areas / Music system buttons / light switches will be disinfected at the end of each day.

Studio floors and gymnastic mat will be disinfected at the end of each week, unless a student has had bare feet, then the floor and mat will be disinfected after each student.

Social Distancing

Student numbers will be limited in the studios to comply with the 2-metre (6.5 foot) gap recommended by the Public Health Agency.

Symptoms of Covid-19

If a student or a member of their household become unwell with a new continuous cough, a high temperature, and /or a change in their sense of smell they are to self-isolate according to government guidelines and not attend classes.

Parents / carers are asked to notify Janice Cotgreave if a student or member of their household are suspected of having Covid 19. If a member of teaching staff or a member of their household have any of the listed symptoms, students who have had classes with that staff member, will be notified.

Any student who displays symptoms of Covid-19 (as described above) during class must be collected from the studios immediately. Parents are reminded to ensure their emergency contact details held by The Dance Space are up to date.

First Aid

If a child sustains an injury during class, the teaching staff reserve the right to assist the child in the most appropriate manner necessary and this may involve some form of physical contact and the use of First Aid. Gloves and masks may be worn during these occasions if deemed appropriate by the staff.

Mental Health

Staff will promote mental health & wellbeing awareness to the students and an open-door policy will be maintained for those who need additional support.

Changing Room. Direct transmission of Covid 19 through the air via coughing and sneezing.

The changing room will be closed until further notice. Students should arrive dressed and ready for class. Students should bring a dance bag into the studio with the following.
